#### Instructions for Application for Partial Wavier of the Florida Child Labor Law for students of Santa Rosa County School District

Chapter 450, Part 1, of the Florida Statutes allows for the partial waiver of certain aspects of the Child Labor Law.

#### Waivers may be granted based on the following:

- Court Order (copy must be attached)
- o Financial Hardship (written statement from parent/guardian)
- o Medical Hardship (written statement from parent/guardian)
- o School status (written documentation detailing school status)
- Other Hardship (written statement from parent/guardian)
- o Entertainment Industry

In order to comply with the regulations regarding the issuance of such a waiver, the following procedure should be followed.

A. After receiving a completed wavier application, (the application must be signed by the student, parent and employer) the principal is to determine that granting such a request would clearly be in the minor's best interest and would not adversely affect the student's ability to perform adequately at school. If the principal signs the application for waiver it then is forwarded with all support documentation to:

B. Upon receipt of the waiver request and documentation, Superintendent will review the application and support documentation for compliance and determine if all conditions have been met. Providing all parties are in compliance, and the wavier is clearly in the best interest of the minor, Superintendent will grant the waiver and forward a copy to all parties involved. The original will remain in the custody of the Director of Workforce Education (Office of Record). Waivers are valid for one year from the date of granting and must be renewed until the minor turns 18 years of age.
